

July 19 Buddina Community Garden Meeting Minutes

Compost - Michael McCuaig, Compost Manager, told the group how the compost must be managed. He instructed that all goods must be thrown into the central booth. The two outside ones will be used at heaps. It is important to toss the compost before moving it to the next booth. The main principle is to put everything in the middle. We need to get signs to inform members of procedure.

Plots 41 - 44 - remain possession of the club - This is to be dealt with at a later date for whatever purposes the group decides. This may include for youth partnership program or related initiatives.

Eggs and Chickens - The chickens cost about \$40 per month to maintain. About 36 per week. Egg collection day is Thursday. Half a dozen eggs costs \$ 2 and a dozen costs \$4 for members only.
